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Nursing Duties

- Obtain and review health and medical information to fulfill state requirements
- Mandatory reports on immunization and communicable diseases
- Implement individualized health plans
- Maintain certification in CPR and the use of defibrillators
- Coordinate health outreach and referrals

Acuity Level Definition

Nursing Dependent – Level I

- Private duty, one-on-one care, e.g. ventilator dependent, feeding tube
- Diabetic with or without insulin pump

Major Nursing Involvement – Level II

- Nurse must interact daily with student
- In most cases, involves skilled nursing procedure
 - -Seizure disorder
 - Nebulizer/rescue inhaler or oxygen therapy

Acuity Level Definition

- Moderate Nursing Involvement Level III
 - Close monitoring of student, without necessarily having to intervene on a daily basis
 - -Significant allergies
 - -Medication administration
 - -Cancer survivors
 - –Mental or behavioral component in student

Acuity Level Definition

- Minor Nursing Involvement Level IV
 - Uncomplicated or predictable concerns
 - Headaches
 - Dietary restrictions
 - Eating disorders
 - Orthopedic conditions requiring accommodation

** This category includes the majority of the school population at a given time.

- Immunization Records "A 45"
- Mandatory flu vaccine to every pre-schooler
- Sixth Grade revised requirements for Tdap,
 Menactra (meningitis vaccine) at the age of 11
- On-going evaluation of immunization status
- State Mandated Health Screenings;
 - oVision
 - oHearing
 - oBody mass index
 - Scoliosis screening
